FOREWARD

Several corpus of work on immigration categories abound in the Nigeria Immigration Service. However, none has been designated 'Nigeria Immigration Service Service Level Agreement' before now. This is not because the NIS Service Level Agreement is entirely novel to the NIS or her operations. What may be new is the commitment and accountability the SLA evokes; the understanding it requires, the practicability (catalyst) it offers and, the attitudinal change it seeks to employ.

Overtime, the propensity to reposition the Service as a huge player in international migration matters and a frontline Immigration Service has led to several reforms in the NIS. With this impetus, the NIS will continue to engage relevant reforms aimed at raising the dial of timely, qualitative and efficient service delivery. Purpose

The purpose of this Service Level Agreement (SLA) is to document commitments between the Nigeria Immigration Service as the service provider and its service takers in line with Business Facilitation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2022. The SLA is an important tool in the efforts to promote transparency and efficiency in public service delivery in Nigeria.

Section 6 of the Act provides guidance for the minimum requirements of an SLA as follows:

An MDA shall have a service level agreement that provides for:

- I. Documentation requirements
- II. Timelines for processing applications
- III. Applicable fees
- IV. A summary of procedure of application
- V. Redress mechanisms and;
- VI. Such other requirement, as the MDA may consider necessary

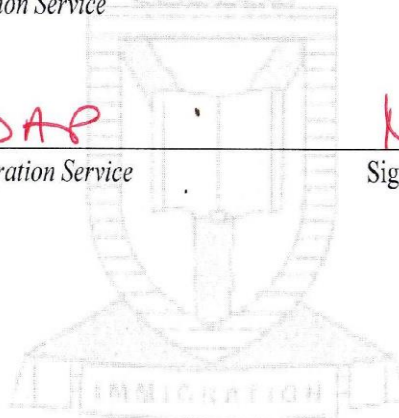
